

## MAT governance: changing structure

For multi-academy trusts, ensuring a robust scheme of delegation and achieving value for money are key for long-term sustainability.

**Lee Miller**, deputy chief executive of the Thinking Schools Academy Trust, 'outlines the savings a trust can make after adapting governance structure.'

'We have 10 academies across two regions, 10 local governing bodies, and 30 local governing body committees.'

'We recognised that this was going to be difficult to manage, going forward.'

## Drivers of change

Consider the *efficiency* of your system. Are there duplications or communication failures?

You may find that there are *conflicts* between individual schools and the overall trust.

Could the cost of senior leadership meetings be reduced?

June: set up governance working group internally



Sept/Oct: working group identified key challenges and chose the preferred option for new structure




Lewin's 3 stages of change management **Unfreeze**: focus on

what's not working

**Move**: identify and carry out changes

Refreeze: focus on the improvements made





'By streamlining some of the decisions made by these regional bodies, we know that further cost savings can be made.'

## Impact of change

Clerking cost savings at estimated £15k per annum.

Hub-based back offices and staffing models for some roles will save an estimated £350k per annum.

Fewer meetings mean senior leaders save time!
